1. Do the following:

- a. Using a map of your city or town, locate where you live.

- b. Draw a map for a friend so he or she can locate your house, a park, a school, or other locations in your neighborhood. Use symbols to show parks, buildings, trees, and water. You can invent your own symbols. Be sure to include a key so your symbols can be identified. (see next page)

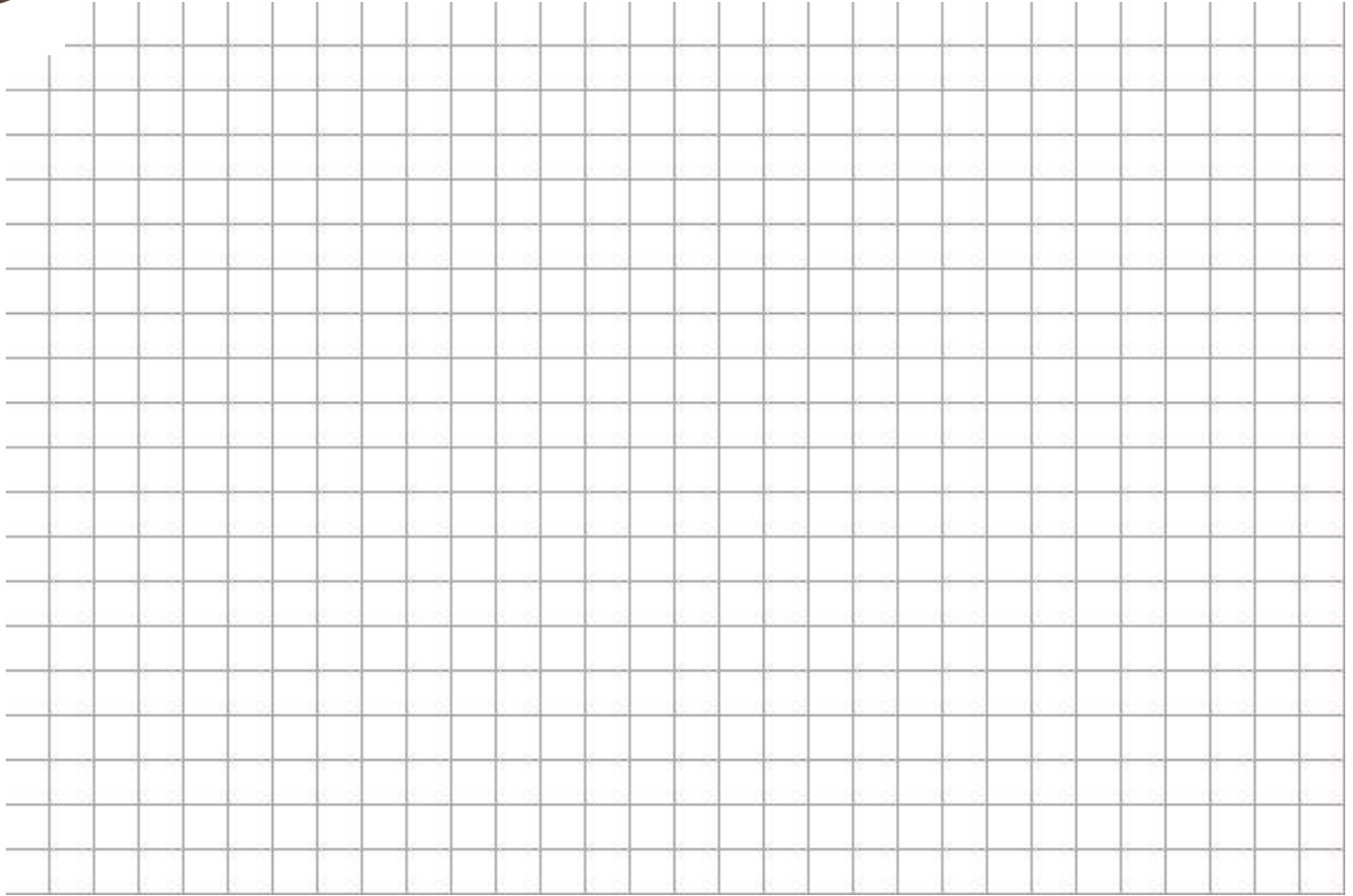
2. Pick a nutritious snack, and find where it came from. Locate that area on a map.

3. Do the following:

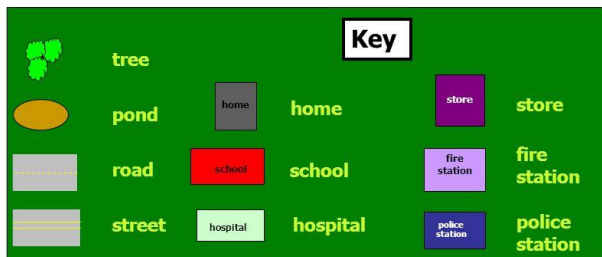
- a. Identify what a compass rose is and where it is on the map.
- b. Use a compass to identify which direction is north. Show how to determine which way is south, east, and west.

4. Go on a scavenger hunt using a compass, and locate an object with a compass.

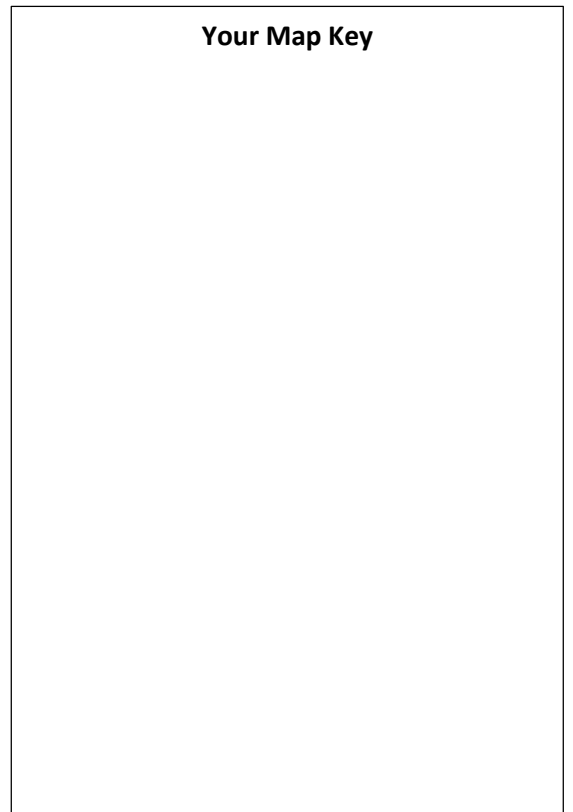
5. Using a map and compass, go on a hike with your den or family.



Some maps have a key. A key is used to describe the pictures that you draw.



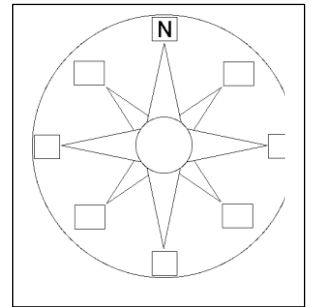
Your Map Key

How to use a compass rose

2. A compass rose is a design on a map that shows directions. It shows north, south, east, west, northeast, northwest, southeast, and southwest. On the compass rose above, only north is filled in. Fill in the rest of the directions on the compass rose, using the standard abbreviations:

N=North, S=South, E=East, W=West, NE=Northeast, NW=Northwest, SE=Southeast, SW=Southwest.

How to use a compass! Go on a hunt and a hike!

1. Hold the compass and know that it will always point to the north. Practice turning your body in different directions and moving the compass to various locations, noting which direction the compass points each time.
2. Practice finding directions other than north. South is the easiest to find, since it's simply the opposite of north. If you want to go south, you just go the opposite of the way the compass is pointing. To find east, go to the right of the direction the compass points. To find west, go to the left of the compass arrow.
3. Once you are proficient at reading basic maps and using a simple compass, combine the two skills and begin using the compass to get from one location to another.
