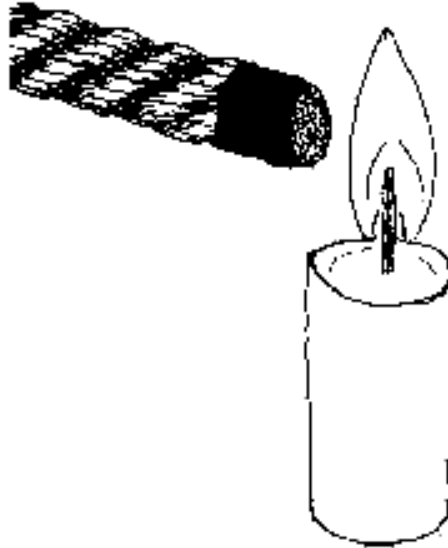


The Square Knot can join two ropes together

WHIPPING A ROPE



Whip and fuse the rope inside your welcome bag.

Ropes tend to unravel when cut, so whipping and fusing will prevent this.

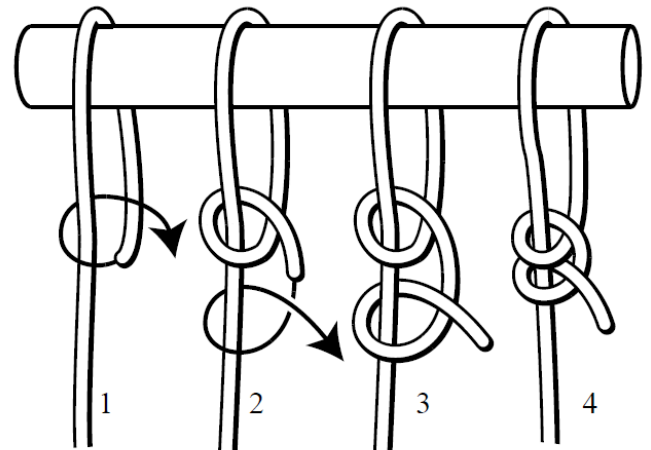
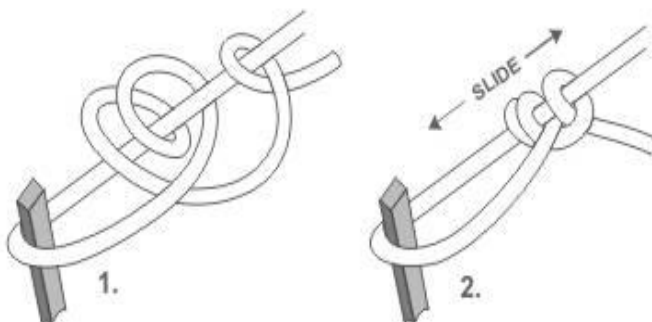
Whip the end of the cut rope with the then dental tape.

Then fuse it with adult supervision with a small flame. This will stay very hot for a while...so let it cool on its own.

TAUTLINE HITCH

The Tautline Hitch is a favorite among campers. This knot is useful for adjusting the tension of tent guy lines and laundry lines, among other uses.

The knot can be slipped to tighten or loosen a line, then holds fast under load.



The Two Half-Hitches knot is the perfect knot to put up a clothesline or tie a hammock between two trees.
