

Stiff Neck Skit

One scout standing center stage with his head tilted way back.

Second scout walks up to first and looks up into the sky to see what he is looking at.

Continue having scouts come onstage making a line until only one scout is left to enter – all are looking up.

Last scout comes onstage and looks up. Then asks the scout ahead of him.

Last Scout: What are you looking at?

Previous Scout: I don't know.

Then, asks the scout ahead of him, ... all the way up to the first scout.

First Scout: I'm not looking at anything. I just have a stiff neck.

You Don't Say - Skit

(Scout #1 pretends to answer a ringing phone and answers it.)

Scout #1: Hello?

Scout #1: You don't say. (hangs up) Each scout comes in the room and answers ringing phone.

Scout #2: Hello? You don't say! (hangs up)

Last Scout walks in: What was that about?

Next to last scout says: I don't know, he didn't say.

I've Got a Cold

Several people enter the room tiptoeing cautiously.

The first one in line whispers "This is where I saw the ghost!" and points.

The message gets passed down the line in a whisper. Everyone states the same thing.

The last person whispers "Where"? and then it gets whispered back to the first of the line.

The first one whispers back "About 20 feet away" and it gets sent down the line.

"How big was he?" (whispers up the line) "About 10 feet tall" (whispers back down the line) "When did you see it?" (whispers up the line) "About 2 months ago" (down the line) "Then WHY are we whispering?" (up the line)

FINALLY the first person says loudly "I've got a cold?"

Viper Skit

3 or more scouts
roll of toilet paper

Script:

(Scout #1 runs in from offstage left and stops at center stage.)

Scout #1: The viper is coming! The viper is coming!

(runs offstage right)

(repeat for each scout until last)

(last scout walks onstage carrying a roll of toilet paper with some streaming back off the roll. Or even wrapped in toilet paper)

Last Scout : I am zee viper. I am zee viper.

(stops at center stage and turns to the audience.)

Last Scout : I am zee viper. Does anyone need a vipe?

Spelling Champ

Two boys enter. The first says “I just won the school spelling bee”

Scout #2 “Then I guess you can tell me how many I’s are in Mississippi.”

Scout #1 “That’s easy – four”

Scout #2 or #3 – “I can spell Mississippi with only *one eye*.”

Scout #1 (or whoever) – “How?”

Scout #2 or #3 – covers one eye with his hand and begins to spell
Mississippi

Yaputcha Skit

Indian Chief is sitting center stage.

Each brave approaches the chief in turn...

Brave: Chief Lightfoot, is it time for Yaputcha?

Chief: (looks at sun, drops some dirt to check wind, sniffs the air, ... whatever you can think of.) No, the time is not right.

The braves sit in a circle which includes the chief.

Finally, when the last brave asks, the Chief checks things out and replies.

Chief: Yes, it is now time for Yaputcha!

Everyone cheers, stands up, and begins the hokey-pokey - "Yaputcha right foot in, Yaputcha right foot out, Yaputcha right foot in and shake it all about..."

2nd scout (Walks to can carrying his mug. He dips his mug in and brings it up to his lips for a drink.)

" THIS CAMP TEA IS GETTING WORSE! "

3rd scout (Walks to can carrying his mug. He dips his mug in and brings it up to his lips for a drink.)

" THIS CAMP CHOCOLATE IS GETTING WORSE! "

4th scout (Walks to can, dips his hands in and takes out a pair of wet socks. As he wrings them out he says.)

"I THOUGHT THAT WOULD GET THEM CLEAN!"

The Lost Quarter

Need: 5 or more scouts.

Scene: One person acts as a lamp post, shining a flashlight on the ground.

Another is groping around in the pool of light. (He's Scout One).

A third person enters, sees Scout One, and asks: "What are you looking for?"

Scout One: "A quarter that I lost".

He joins # 1, and helps him search. A fourth and fifth enter and repeat the above scene.

Finally one of them asks Scout One: "Where did you lose the quarter?"

Scout One: (Pointing away) "Over there"

Other Scout: "Then why are you looking here?"

Scout One: "Because the light is better over here!"

The Invisible Bench

Need: 4 (or more) scouts

First boy is squatting as though sitting on an invisible bench. The second boy comes in and asks what the first is doing.

"I'm sitting on the invisible bench."

"Can I join you?"

"Sure, there's plenty of room."

Second boy pretends to sit.

A third boy comes along, and the scene repeats.

Go on for as many boys as you want.

When the last boy comes along, asks what they are doing and is answered, he says

"But I moved it over there this morning!"

AAAAHHHHHH!!!! All seated boys fall down.

Nosebleed

Person with nosebleed, 3 Pedestrians, 4th Pedestrian

(Nosebleed person is looking down at the ground. #1 comes in and looks around, then down, and mumbles.)

#1: Hmm, what's going down, man? (No answer.)

#2 walks in, does the same thing, as does #3. #4 walks in, looks up for a moment, then asks,

#4: What are you guys doing?

Nosebleed: I don't know what these guys are doing, but I've got a nosebleed!

Pass the Pepper

Setting: Family Sitting at the Dinner Table, talking in a very thick Southern Drawl. As many scouts in a line as you wish.

Ma: Pass the peppa, Pa.

(Goes down the line to Pa, who responds)

Pa: Here's the Black Peppa, Ma.

(Goes down the line to Ma, who responds)

Ma: No, not the Black Peppa, Pa.

(Goes down the line to Pa, who responds)

Pa: Oh. Here's the Chili Peppa, Ma.

(This goes on through different kinds of Peppa i.e. Banana Peppa, Jalapeno Peppa, Red Peppa, Green Peppa, and so on until,)

Ma: Can't you pass the toilet peppa, Pa?

Food, Water & Mirror on the Sahara

2 or more People, cup of water, combs, Narrator

Setting: Sahara Desert

Narrator: Here are some poor, thirsty men on the desert who've been stranded on the desert for days.

Let's watch.

(Two or three people are crawling, calling out for water. Time to really ham it up. Finally, they see the cup of water and stagger for it, reaching out.

Finally, they get to the water and,)

People: Ahhhh! (Relieved-they take out combs, dip them in water and begin to comb hair.)

What's the Problem?

Scout 1 (Crying on stage)

Scout 2 (Sees scout #1) What's the problem?

Scout #1 (Whispers in kid's ear.)

#2 begins to cry too.

#3: Hey! What's the problem?

#1 whispers in #2's ear, and he starts crying too. Continue with #3 and #4. (Finally, Campfire Chief comes around.)

Chief: Hi! I've come around to collect skit names for the campfire tonight!

Hey! What's the problem?

All: We don't have a skit!

Cub Scout Socks

Characters: Den leader, 3 Cub Scouts

Props: A pile of socks on a table. Den leader sits behind table.

Den leader: Boys, I'm pleased to announce that our new Cub Scout socks have arrived!

Please step up for your supply of clean socks.

Cub #1: I need four pair.

Den leader: What do you need 4 pair for?

Cub #1: I need them for Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday.
